

ITINERARY FOR GERMANY - AUSTRIA - SWITZERLAND - PARIS

Day 1: Munich:

Welcome to Germany! Our representative will meet and greet you at the airport take a half day city tour Munich visiting the old and new art gallery, the national theatre and the royal residence, the Marienplatz Square with the old and new town hall and the "Mariensaule" column, the church of Saint Peter and the famous Viktualienmarkt square with its fine food stands. Afterward, we will continue to Nymphenburg castle and have a walk through the gardens. Finally, having arrived at the Olympia Park, enjoy the splendid panoramic view over the city of Munich

Day 2: Heidelberg-Black Forest

Today, get ready to marvel at the ancient city of Heidelberg on the banks of the River Neckar. After a brief tour of the Old Bridge, the Holy Ghost Church and the city's other historic sites, we'll board a small train for the short trip to Heidelberg Castle. Looming over the city of Heidelberg and the River Neckar. This massive fortress dates back to the Middle Ages. Our guided tour will include a spectacular, panoramic view of the city before we return to Heidelberg. Later we'll travel south into the Black Forest for dinner at our hotel.

Day 3: Munich - Vienna (460 kms approx. 8 - 9 hrs)

Full day sightseeing of Neuschwanstein Castle and enjoy there. Your guide will tell the engaging story of King Ludwig's renowned and tragic reign, of his turbulent times, and of the obsession that drove him to build his fantasy castle in the mountains that ultimately destroyed him. Take an exclusive internal tour of the king's private chambers with a specialist castle guide. Overnight in bus from Munich to Vienna.

Day 4: Vienna

Arrive Vienna and leave for the half day city tour Along the Ringstrasse we show you numerous magnificent buildings, such as the MAK, the State Opera House, the Museum of Fine Arts and the Natural History Museum, the cultural district the Museums Quartier, the former Habsburg winter residence, the Hofburg, the Parliament, the City Hall and the Burg theater. The highlight of this tour will be a visit of the showrooms of Schonbrunn Palace. In this former summer residence of the Habsburg family lived. On the way back to the opera we pass by the Belvedere Palace, the former summer residence of Prince Eugen, which houses the largest and the most precious Gustav Klimt collection in the world. Evening at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 5: Vienna - Zurich (767 kms approx 13-14 hrs)

Morning after breakfast proceed to visit Belvedere Palaces, The two magnificent palaces on the Belvedere grounds lie in the middle of a splendid park. Schönbrunn Zoo is the world's oldest and only baroque zoo, St. Stephen's Cathedral defines the city centre and has been the heart of Vienna for centuries, Ring Boulevard is 14 kilometres long and circles the city centre. Overnight in bus from Vienna to Zurich.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 6: Zurich

Arrive Zurich and leave for half day, tour passing by the most important sights in the city of Zürich, such as the castle-like National Museum, the world-famous Bahnhofstrasse, historic Limmatquai, Zürich's Opera House, St. Peter's Church with Europe's largest clock face and Lake Zürich. The tour also includes a ride with the cogwheel train up to the Zürichberg city quarter with its villas from a past era

Day 7: Zurich - Geneva (299 kms approx 6-7 hrs)

After breakfast proceed to enjoy the full day excursion at Mount Titlis on this guided coach tour from Zurich. Appreciate the Alps and their unmatched views from such great heights, including a cable car ride to the summit, a ride on the ice flyer and free time in Lucerne. Overnight in the bus from Zurich to Geneva.

Day 8: Geneva

Arrive Geneva for lunch and transfer to the hotel and check in. Later in the afternoon visit Lake Geneva, if a visitor follows the shore of lake Geneva, they can admire the changing colours, the terraced slopes with their vineyards and Patek Philippe Museum, home to the prestigious creations of the Geneva-based firm of master watchmakers which was founded in 1839. Discover how a passion for timepieces has brought together an extraordinary display of watches, musical automata and portrait miniatures from the 16th to the 19th century, in addition to a library dedicated entirely to horology and its related subjects. Overnight in Geneva.

Day 9: Geneva

After breakfast proceed for a full day at Signal de Bougy This immense park of 42 hectares above Aubonne is designed for relaxation and recreation; with a splendid self-service restaurant where families can make themselves completely at home. Walking paths are also suitable for baby carriages; wonderful view over Lake Geneva and the Swiss and French Alps; deer park; numerous outdoor games. You can also visit the old bread oven and put your name down for a beginner's course at the bakery. Overnight in Geneva.

Day 10: Geneva-Paris (541 kms approx. 10-11hrs)

After breakfast proceed for a city tour of Geneva's most famous monument, The Jet d'eau, the world's tallest water fountain and provides a constant landmark for exploring the city. Geneva's ancient Old Town offers a living glimpse of the past while Geneva's more than thirty museums and art galleries capture the rich and vibrant history of the city including the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Museum and the Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art (MAMCO). For a change of pace take a cruise on the lake or relax in one of Geneva's man waterfront parks. Overnight in a bus from Geneva to Paris.

Day 11: Paris

Arrive Paris for late breakfast and half day city tour around Paris. Your coach tour across Paris takes in Place de la Concorde Square, the Champs-Elysees, the Arc de Triomphe, the western districts of Paris, the Palais de Chaillot and the Palais Bourbon (National Assembly). After the city tour check in to hotel and freshen up for an evening cruise on Seine River which gives you and all round view of Paris. Dinner and overnight in Paris.

Day 12: Paris

After breakfast proceed to Louvre, Musée du Louvre or Grand Louvre is the biggest museum in France and one of the most visited and known museums in the world. It is famous for the Mona Lisa by Leonardo Da Vinci. Enjoy the scenic beauty of the surrounding place on your way to Louvre. Spend the entire day here. Dinner and overnight in Paris.

Day 13: Paris

After breakfast proceed to visit the Notre Dames, it is the most well known Cathedral in the world. The Notre Dames is a gothic cathedral on the island, Ile de la Cite. It was one of the first gothic cathedrals and the construction lasted the entire gothic period. After lunch proceed to visit the Eiffel Tower an icon of Paris, pronounced in French as "Tour Eiffel". The Eiffel tower is created in the 19th Century to be a temporary exhibition for the Universal Exposition. Overnight in Paris.

Day 14: Paris

After breakfast you are free to explore Paris and to shop to your heart's content in the city which is the heart of big fashion names. Take an evening flight back to Mumbai.
